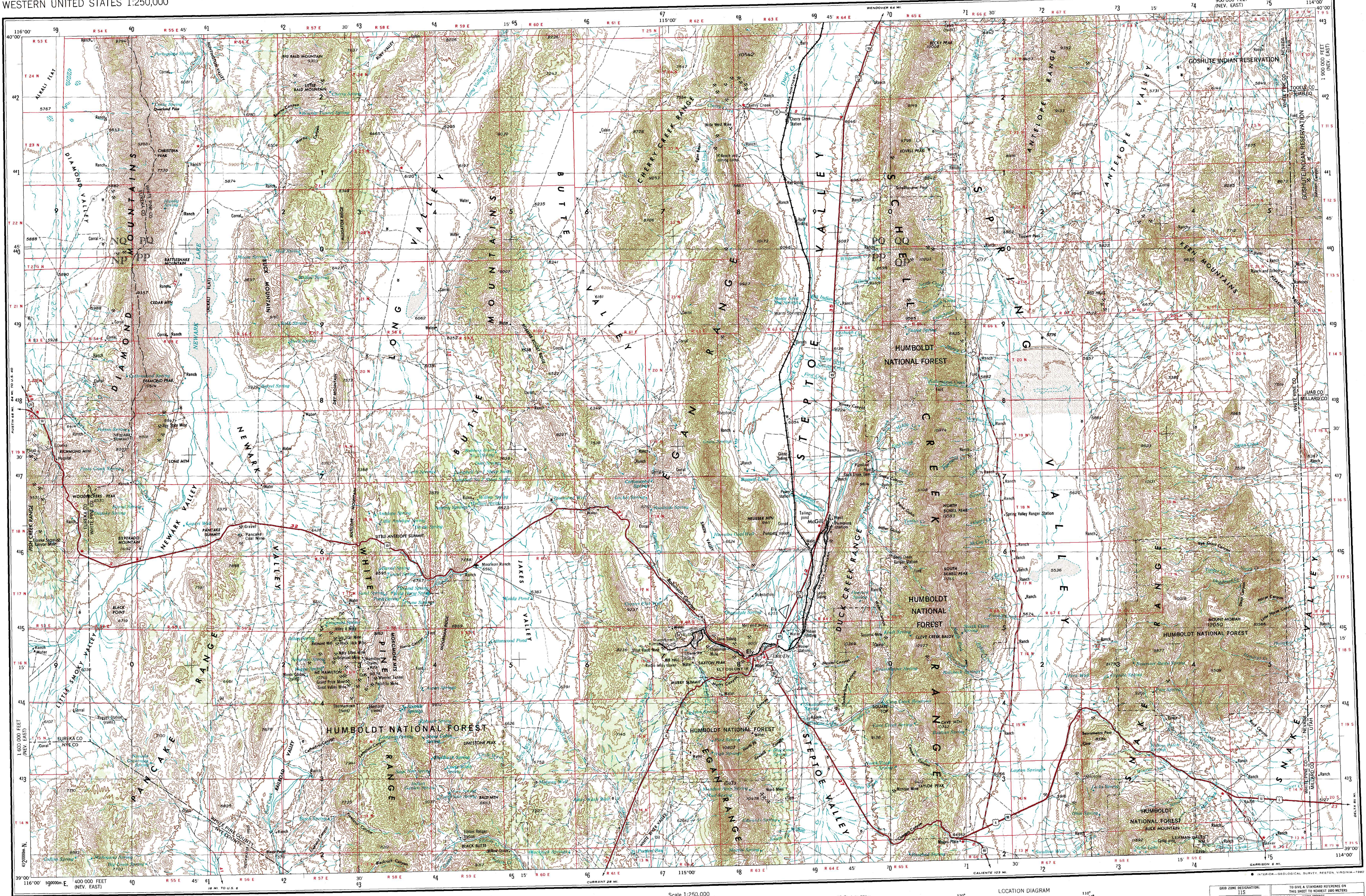

Transverse Mercator Projection. 10,000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid zone 11. 100,000-foot grid ticks based on Nevada coordinate system east zone. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 10 meters north and 74 meters east. Location of geodetic control established by government agencies is shown on corresponding 1:250,000-scale Geodetic Control Diagram. There may be private holdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
