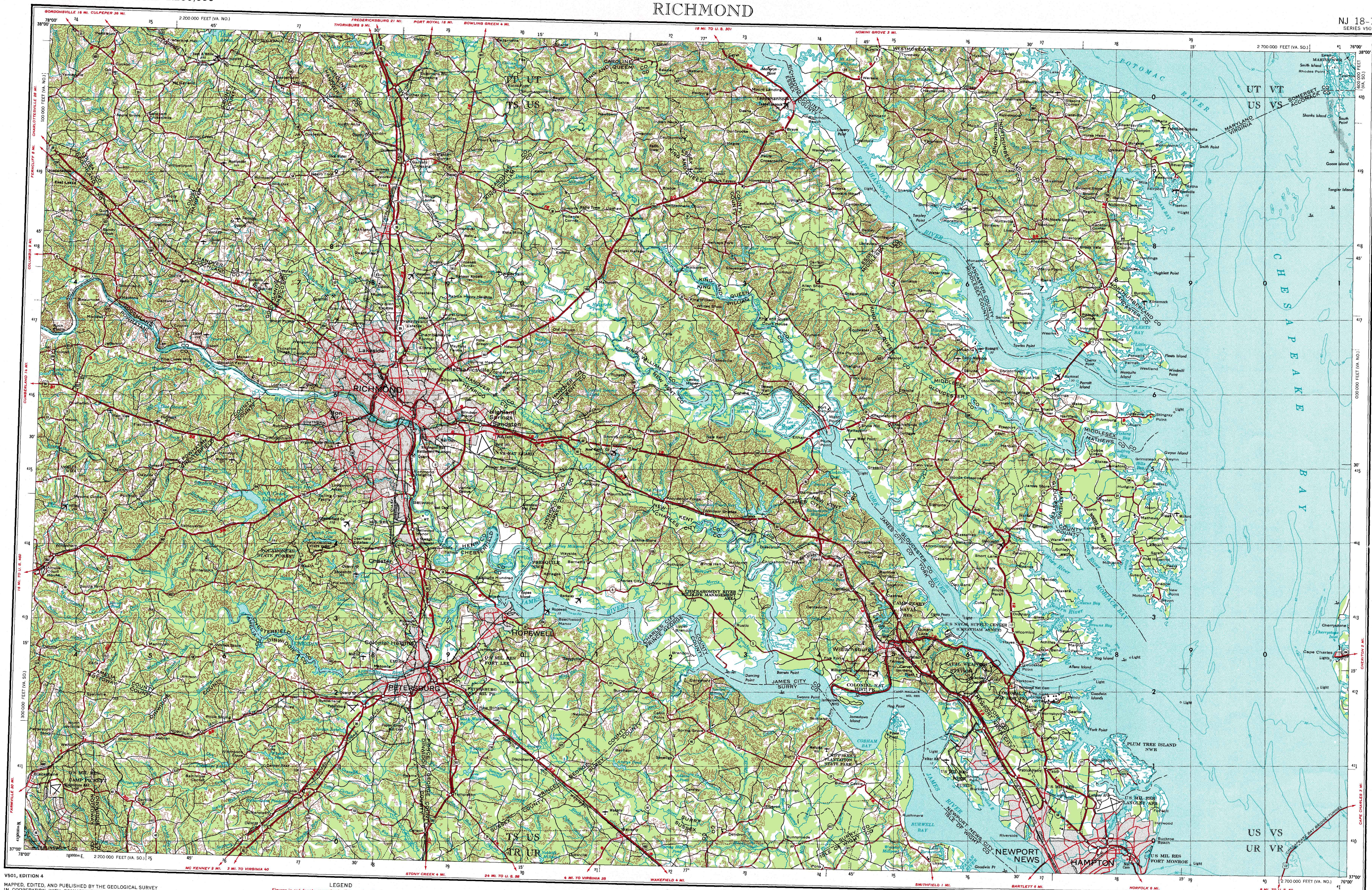
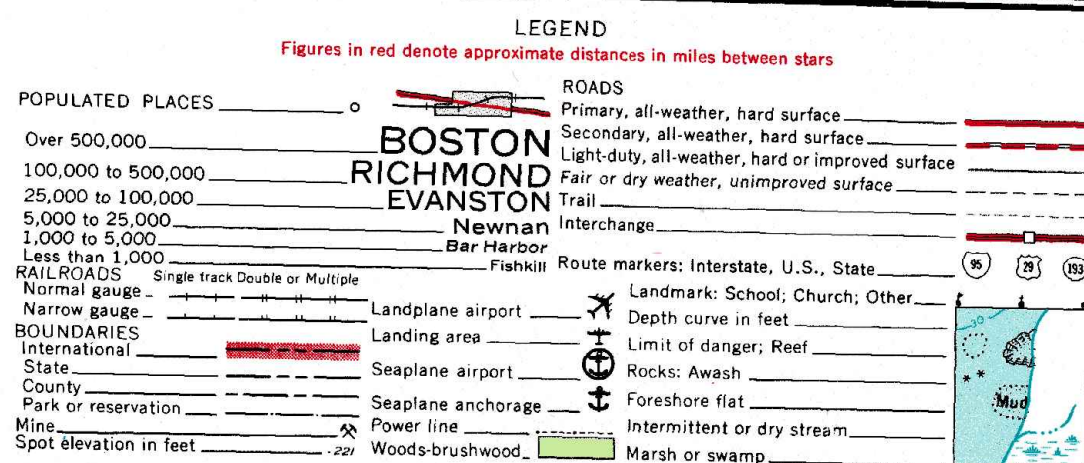
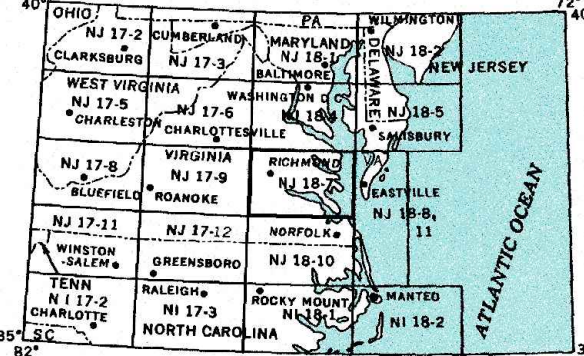

18S	18S	3. Locate first horizontal and line to right of point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the left or right margin, or on the line itself.	
18S	18S	4. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
